- Ref. 2384 .22 lr Ruger Model 10/22 semi-auto rifle. Beech stock. Fitted with scope rail. Good condition. £185**
- Ref. 2779 .22 lr Norinco bolt action training rifle in the style of a Mauser 98K service rifle. Full military specs. Good condition £185**
- Ref. 2780 .45-70 Pedersoli Remington rolling block Silhouette target rifle. 30" octagonal barrel with buckhorn rear sight and adjustable tunnel fore sight with spirit level. Double set triggers. Fitted with Pedersoli Silhouette long target rear sight. Walnut pistol grip butt. With spare fore-sight elements and spirit level bubbles. Very good condition £850**
- Ref. 2798. .45 Colt Marlin Model 1894CB (1894 Cowboy Limited) lever action rifle. 24" octagonal barrel with full-length magazine. Buck-horn rear sight. Excellent condition £885**
- Ref. 2809. .577 Parker Hale Enfield Pattern 1853 rifle musket . Early model with Parker Hale roundel to butt. Excellent condition with ramrod £225**
- Ref. 2810. .303 Short, Magazine Lee Enfield No.1. Mk.III by London Small Arms Company, dated 1915. Matching numbered bolt & fore-end cap. Full military specs with windage adjustable rear sight, full volley sights and magazine cut-off. Overall service wear to wood-work, otherwise good condition. £545**

- Ref. 2811. .22 War Office Pattern 1908 bolt action training rifle, by the London Small Arms Company. Complete and in very good condition. £155**
- Ref. 2813. .22 W.W. Greener martini action cadet rifle. 25 ¼ “ barrel, full-stocked with two barrel bands. Ladder rear sight. Hand-detachable lock. Sling swivels & steel cleaning rod. Hand-detachable barrel with lever to left of action. Some age wear overall otherwise very good condition. £155**
- Ref. 2833 .577 bp Parker Hale Enfield Pattern 1858 Naval percussion service rifle. Full military specs with steel ramrod. Very good condition. £255**

ANTIQUUE GUNS

All guns in this section are classed as collectibles; Section 58(2) under the firearms act and can be purchased without certificates.

- Ref.01334 .451 Westley Richards “Monkey Tail capping breechloader short rifle. 25 ½ “ barrel marked “Whitworth Patent” with ladder rear sight. Breech lever marked “Manufactured by Westley Richards”. Lock plate marked “Westley Richards & Co. and 1875 in triangle. Some old pitting to metalwork and small old repair to stock. Otherwise good working order and condition. Possibly used by the Boers in the First Boer War. £765**
- Ref. 2741 .577 Enfield Pattern 1856 percussion short service rifle. Lock marked Crown, V.R. Tower , 1857. 33” barrel with bayonet bar. Full military specs. Original steel ramrod. Good working order & condition £565**
- Ref. 2758 12.17 x 44R Swedish Model 1867 Remington Rolling Block service rifle. One of the first batch of rifles made by Remington for Sweden before they started manufacture in Sweden. This example is in the original rimfire state, rare as most were converted to centre-fire. 37 ¼ “ barrel with ladder rear sight, three barrel bands and cleaning rod.SOLD**

- Ref. 2777** 17 bore mid 19th c. English single barrel percussion sporting gun. 32” heavy barrel retained by a single cross bolt; with full proof marks and indistinct makers stamp. Engraved lock plate and engraved brass trigger guard & butt plate. Brass tipped wood ramrod. Slight old worm to stock, otherwise good working order & condition. **£225**
- Ref. 2778** .650 cal. military percussion carbine. English made by “R.R.” with full proof marks and dated 1861. 21” browned barrel retained by single cross bolt. Plain lock plate. Steel ramrod. Half-stocked. Small piece of wood missing from fore end otherwise good working order & condition. **£265**
- Ref.2791** .65 cal. Indian Sergeants Fusil percussion musket. 33” barrel with block rear sight. Two barrel bands. Iron furniture. Lock with East India Company rampant lion. Age wear overall **£195**
- Ref. 2828** 80 bore flintlock pocket pistol by John Mabson and J.A. Labron of Russel St. Birmingham. Circa. 1810. 2 ¼ “ round turn-off barrel, Birmingham proofed. Action engraved with stand-of-arms on one side and makers name on the other. Sliding bar safety and walnut grip. Very good working order and condition with clean bore. **£325**
- Ref. 2829** .380 Long Rifle Martini-Zeller action rook rifle by Adams & Co. of 9, Finsbury Place, South London. 27” octagonal barrel fitted with blade fore sight and three-leaf rear sight (50, 75 & 100 yards) Signed by maker on top rear flat of barrel. One-piece walnut stock, chequered at wrist and fore end. Made circa. 1875. Some age wear overall, general good condition with good bore. **£565**
- Ref. 2830** .50-70 gov. Springfield Model 1866 Allin trapdoor service rifle. Full military specs. Scarce two-band variation. Very good condition. **£1650**
- Ref. 2831** .310 cadet B.S.A. Model 4b. martini training rifle. Full military specs with adjustable rear sight. Full markings for New South Wales issue. Good working order & condition. **£795 SOLD**

- Ref. 2832 .577 Snider-Enfield Mk.II cavalry carbine. Converted from a P.53 rifle. Lock dated 1875. Brass furniture. Metalwork refinished. Good working order and condition . £485**
- Ref. 2836 Fine quality 14 bore single barrel flintlock sporting gun by Jonathon Bellis of London, circa 1810. 30 ½” three-stage barrel with gold band inlay to breech and platinum touch hole, retained by single cross bolt. Engraved lock with makers name and roller frizzen. Gold inlay decoration to trigger guard. Nicely figured pale walnut stock. Small old crack to stock, otherwise very good working order and condition. £795**
- Ref. 2841 Scarce .577 Enfield Pattern 1856 percussion cavalry carbine. Made by the Birmingham Small Arms Trade. Lock dated 1863. 21” barrel, three-groove rifled with two-leaf rear sight and captive ramrod. Brass furniture and sling ring bar to left side of action. Two barrel bands. Very good working order and condition with clean bore. £795**
- Ref. 2842 .577/450 Westley Richards Martini-Francotte service rifle. 32 ½ “ barrel with ladder rear sight. action marked “Made Specially For Z.A.R.” Dated 1898. Fore end reduced to “kaal-lope” with single barrel band as was common with some owners in the 2nd Boer War. Some age wear overall , otherwise good working order and condition. £645**
